I have been unable to obtain any information about him and the members of the family that I talked with about him stated that he never married.

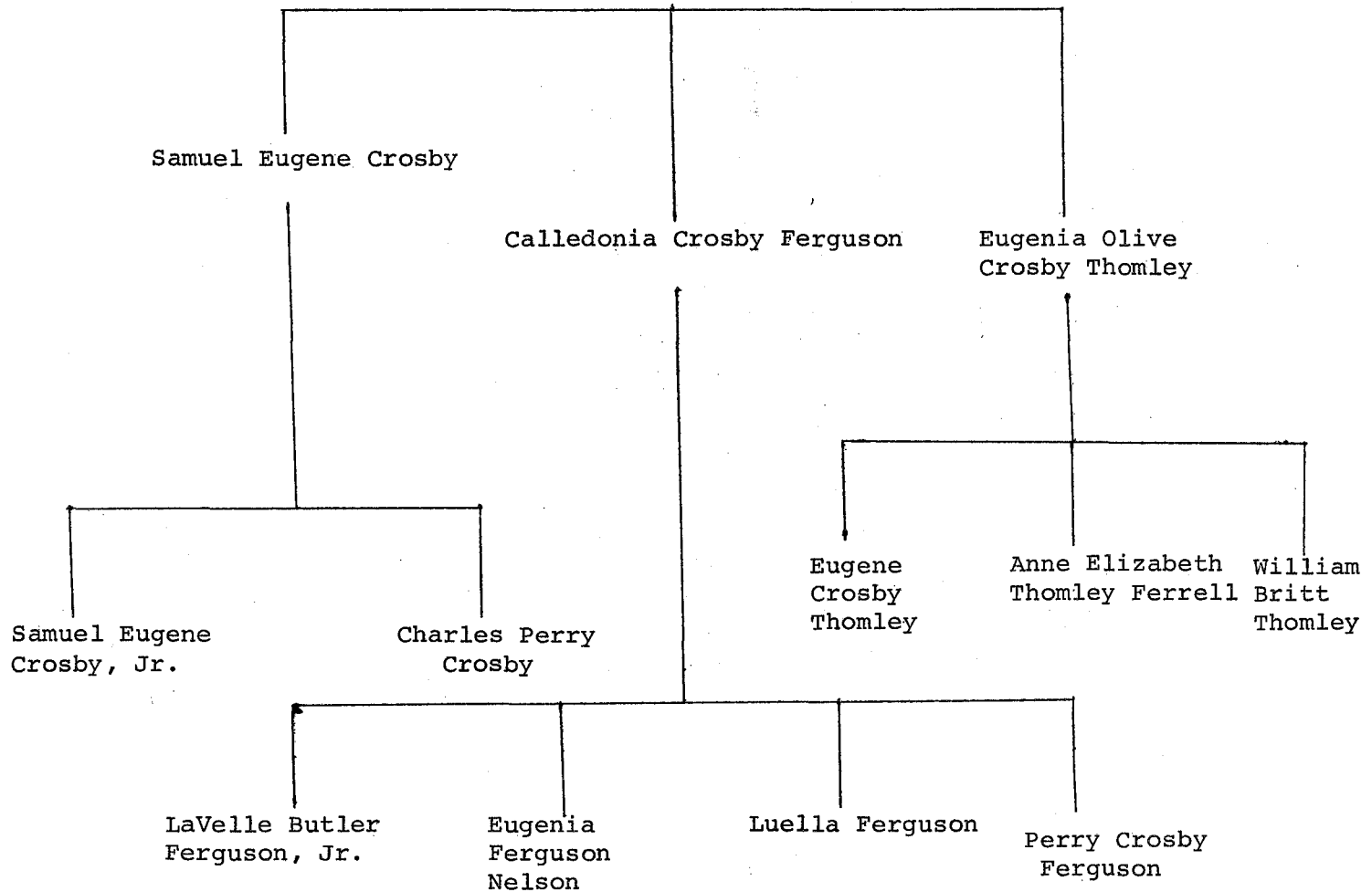
THE FAMILY OF PERRY WELSH CROSBY

Perry was a farmer and also ran a commissary and naval store. Although Perry did not fight in the Civil War like his older brothers Boss and Will, he came to Stockton at the end of the War on foot with two oxen named Jim and Joe. On his way, he met Thaddeus Ferguson who was a Prisoner of War who had recently been released from a Yankee prison. Mr. Ferguson was heading to Latham on a horse and he assisted Perry by allowing him to ride the horse at intervals while Mr. Ferguson walked the oxen. Years later, Perry's daughter, Callie married Mr. Ferguson's son, LaVelle.
