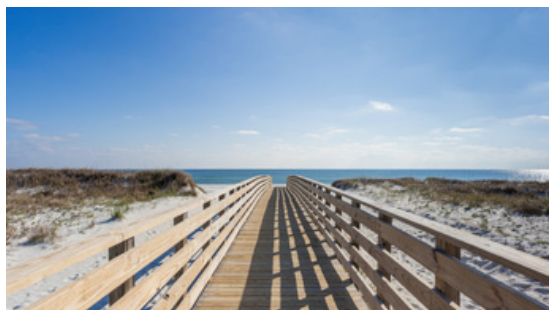
BEACH SAFE

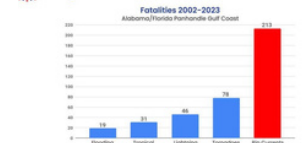

SEVERE WEATHER SAFETY

BE WEATHER AWARE
Have multiple ways to receive warnings

SHELTER
Take shelter inside a sturdy building or storm shelter
Have a backup plan for shelter if outdoors
Stay away from windows

GET OUT OF A MOBILE HOME
It cannot withstand winds of 70-mph or falling trees
Go to a sturdy building or storm shelter

VEHICLES
Watch for fallen trees in the road from damaging wind
Last resort - Vehicles can provide shelter from hail
