NOTICE

To All License Inspectors, County Probate Judges, County License Commissioners, and Other Licensing Officials

Chief United States District Judge Sharon Lovelace Blackburn issued a ruling on September 28, 2011 regarding the temporary injunction which enjoined Act 2011-535, the Beason-Hammon Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act, commonly referred to as the Immigration Act. Effective September 28, 2011, taxing officials and county officials are required to obtain documentation from applicants proving either citizenship and/or lawful presence in order to conduct a business transaction with the State and/or counties. A list of acceptable documents was included in the Notice to you dated August 11, 2011. ALVerify (<https://alverify.mvtrip.alabama.gov/>) provides the ability to verify an Alabama driver license or non-driver identification card for the purpose of demonstrating U.S. citizenship and/or legal presence in the U.S. It is recommended that a copy of the verification code and/or failure code be maintained by the user for future reference.
